SAN JOSE

FEBRUARY 5-7, 2018

ARENAL NATIONAL PARK

San Jose is the country's social, political and commercial center, and it's more cosmopolitan and prosperous than many other cities in Central America. Sitting in the middle of the fertile Valle Central (Central Valley), it has volcanoes to the north and a rugged tectonic mountain chain to the south. This capital city has entered a revitalization period - cultural events are thriving and older areas have revived thanks to the boom in tourism. The city is blessed with excellent restaurants, notable art galleries and museums.

TORTUGUERO
