#### DAY 1: THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 16

Depart for your flight to New York City. Transfer to the Novotel New York Times Square Hotel for check-in. The afternoon is at leisure.

With its sophisticated styling, the newly-redesigned 4-Star Novotel New York Times Square invites you to experience the electricity of Times Square. Located in the heart of Manhattan, right in the Theater district, this unique Midtown luxury hotel is within walking distance to New York's best attractions, including Times Square, Central Park and prestigious 5th Avenue.

#### **DAY 2: FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 17**

This morning take an optional walk over to the Today Show or the Good Morning America Show and be part of the audience that gathers outside the studios each morning. Signs are welcome and will increase your chances of being caught on camera! Afterwards, return to the hotel to begin the morning guided sightseeing tour of the city by motorcoach.

See all the sights that make the Big Apple so special! Our knowledgeable and entertaining tour guide will give us a taste of the Big Apple while we learn fascinating insights and discover the real New York (there will be several photo opportunity stops). Our tour will begin at the center of it all - Times Square! See the lights that make NYC famous, as well as The Great White Way of Broadway.

We will also visit Rockefeller Center to see where NBC's Today Show is filmed, and stop in Central Park to view Strawberry Fields and the nearby Dakota Building where John Lennon lived. Pass by one of the most well-known shopping streets in the world – Fifth Avenue and its famous shops such as Tiffany's, FAO Schwarz, St. Patrick's Cathedral and the Plaza Hotel. Following our visit of Midtown, we will head to Lower Manhattan where you will get to see the New York Stock Exchange, Wall Street, World Financial Center and Ground Zero, as well as check out the amazing architecture of St. Paul's Chapel and Trinity Church.

Tonight, take in one of New York's finest Broadway shows.

#### **DAY 3: SATURDAY. NOVEMBER 18**

Today, you have an opportunity to join the Optional Walking Tour of Chelsea Market and the Meatpacking District. Chelsea Market is a food hall, shopping mall, office building and home to the Food Network. This block long and block wide market is a foodie's paradise! There are more than 35 vendors purveying everything from soup to nuts, wine to coffee, cheese to cheesecake. We'll enjoy several tastings during our walk through the market before continuing through the Meatpacking District for more delectable tastings. This 24-hour neighborhood is an epicenter of activity and full of contrasts. Walk through the neighborhood and see high heels straddle the Belgian block stone streets, historical architecture with contemporary structures being built above, and observe the grit of an industrial backbone and the chic of today's industry. We end with a leisurely stroll along the High Line - a public park that is 1.45 miles long and built on a historic freight rail line elevated above the streets of Manhattan's West Side, running from Gansevoort Street in the Meatpacking District to West 34th Street, between 10th and 12th Avenues. 
#### DAY 4: SUNDAY NOVEMBER 19
