DAY 1 | SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2025 INTERNATIONAL FLIGHT TO ICELAND

Depart from Minneapolis for your overnight flight to Reykjavik, Iceland.

# DAY 2 | MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 29, 2025 REYKJAVIK, ICELAND

Arrive in Iceland where you will be met by Carrousel Travel representatives who will escort you to your motorcoach for transportation to the Hotel Reykjavik Saga.

This evening enjoy a welcome dinner at Las Primavera Restaurant.

### DAY 3 | TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 30, 2025 THE GOLDEN CIRCLE

After breakfast at your hotel, depart for your first day of adventure as you travel to Þingvellir which is situated on the northern shore of Lake Pingvallavatn, the largest natural lake in Iceland. Þingvellir is a remarkable geological phenomenon and the most important historical site in Iceland. It is the site of the world's oldest parliament founded in the year 930 AD by the settlers of Iceland. The beautiful Almannagiá canyon that runs through the park is a boundary meeting of two of the earth's tectonic plates and the combination of both natural wonder and historical significance makes it inseparable from the fabric of Icelandic national life. The river Öxará traverses the national park and forms Öxarárfoss waterfall at Almannagjá canyon. In 2004 Pingvellir was inscribed on UNESCO's World Heritage List.



Afterwards, continue with a visit to a Geothermal Bakery for a tour and tasting. Get an introduction of this age-old method of baking bread using the hot ground in Iceland. Tasting includes a slice of Geyser Bread with butter and egg or trout.

Enjoy lunch today in Skálholt. Skálholt is one of the most historic places in Iceland. It was an episcopal see, a school, a seat of learning and administration for more than 700 years and a place of pilgrimage in medieval times.

From here continue to the Hotel Geysir, your home for the next few nights. Dinner will be served tonight at your hotel.

### DAY 4 | WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 1, 2025 THE GOLDEN CIRCLE

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel before starting your day. For your second day at the Golden Circle you'll explore Gullfoss waterfall and the Geysir geothermal area. The spouting hot spring Geysir was claimed to be the biggest one in the world. The old Geysir has been mostly dormant for decades, but when it was active, its eruptions reached the height of at least 80 meters (262 feet). There are spouting hot springs all around the area, such as the ever-lively Strokkur, which erupts every three to five minutes.

Next it is onward to a Snowmobile Safari. These snowmobiles are two-seated touring sleds with hand warmers and a high windshield. The professional guides will take you on an adventure in the Icelandic highlands, giving you the most amazing views of the majestic Langjökull glacier and its surroundings.



Langjökull, Iceland's second biggest glacier, is composed of several enormous, ice-filled volcanic craters and rimmed in by imposing volcanoes. You will see the steep Eiríksjökull glacier, the highest mountain in west Iceland, the dome shaped Hofsjökull glacier in the middle of the highlands, and the Kerlingafjöll Mountain range.

Continue to Gullfoss for lunch. Gullfoss, the "Golden Waterfall" is the most famous of the country's many waterfalls. Here the river Hvítá drops 96 feet in two falls, creating an awesome spectacle. Witness thousands of tons of icy water thunder majestically down in a double-fall into a deep gorge. There is a certain rawness, power, and vastness to Gullfoss which leaves most people who visit feeling quite humble in the face of the raw power of nature.

This evening enjoy a fabulous dinner at Friðheimar Tomato Farm.

### DAY 5 | THURSDAY, OCTOBER 2, 2025 SOUTH ICELAND

After breakfast, witness the beauty of South Iceland, known for its diverse landscape of gorgeous waterfalls, lush farmlands, glaciers, icecapped volcanoes, black-sand volcanic beaches, and towering mountains and cliffs. On this exclusive tour, you'll travel in specially modified luxury Super Jeeps and see some of the most popular sights of the south coast of Iceland as well as some lesser-known gems.

Super Jeeps are crafted for uniquely tough conditions and are the result of decades of insular technical innovation and evolution. From tinkering with old army Jeeps to get further uphill, to hand-built monsters, Super Jeeps are equally at home crossing Antarctica, the wild Icelandic Highlands or even the highway. They are only piloted by a trained professional.



Seljalandsfoss is a unique, breathtakingly beautiful waterfall that can be fully encircled. The water flows in the river Seljalandsá from Eyjafjallajökull volcano and drops about 65 meters (200ft) over an ancient sea cliff into a pool.

Skógafoss is one of the largest and most elegant waterfalls in Iceland. Due to the mist and amount of spray, the waterfall consistently produces a single or double rainbow which is normally visible on sunny days. Ancient folklore tells the tale of Þrasi, the first Viking settler in the area, who buried his chest of gold in a cave behind the waterfall.

Dinner is included at a local restaurant before spending your overnight at UMI Hotel.

### DAY 6 | FRIDAY, OCTOBER 3, 2025 SOUTH ICELAND

Today you will experience more of the South Coast as well as the amazing natural Ice Caves of Mýrdalsjökull.

The first stop will be the beautiful Reynisfjara black beach, featuring an amazing cliff of regular basalt columns resembling a rocky step pyramid called Gardar. Out in the sea are the spectacularly shaped basalt sea stacks, Reynisdrangar.

Next you will visit the village of Vík and have a lunch break. Lastly, it is time to head off the beaten track on specially modified Super Jeeps towards the glacier where you`ll experience the natural wonder of the ice caves of Mýrdalsjökull. Visiting a natural ice cave has never been this easy. The trip departs from Vík through the black sands of Mýrdalssandur onwards to Kötlujökull.



The trip takes you through a beautiful and strange area that has been used for filming TV shows and movies such as Game of Thrones and Star Wars: Rogue One. You'll see powerful rivers, vast stretches of black sandy plains, beautiful green promontories like Hafursey and Hjörleifshöfði rising from the desert, and the beautiful mountains and glacier that make up the area of the volcano Katla.

The trip to the glacier takes around 30-60 minutes. Upon arrival at the glacier, you'll gear up to walk towards the ice caves, an easy walk of 5-15 minutes. You'll spend around 45-60 minutes exploring the glacier and ice cave while your guide gives you insight about the formation of the ice caves and the glacier. All necessary gear is provided.

This evening you will have a group dinner at the UMI Restaurant.

# DAY 7 | SATURDAY, OCTOBER 4, 2025 REYKJAVIK, ICELAND

Relax this morning before you depart. Enjoy a wonderful lunch at Tryggvaskáli, a charming restaurant on the bank of the Ölfusá river, offering a great view over the river. Tryggvaskáli is the oldest house in Selfoss and plays a big role in the town 's history. Tryggvi Gunnarsson built the house as he was establishing the bridge over the Ölfusá river. The house was used for the workers while the bridge was being built, but since 1901 it has been used as a restaurant and a guesthouse.

Afterwards you will take a special adventure. Enjoy a three-hour cruise aboard the Amelia Rose, the grandest yacht available in Reykjavík. This is the best opportunity to experience the magic of Faxaflói Bay, whether it is whale watching or bird watching, sea angling or just a cruise enjoying the beautiful environment of the Bay of Reykjavík.



Reykjavík is very close to some of the best whale watching grounds in the country. In less than an hour you will be in a prime spot to catch a glimpse of a number of species of whales including humpbacks, minke whales, pilot whales and a few species of dolphins.

Arrive at Reykjavik and check into the Hotel Reykjavik Saga. Dinner is on your own tonight.
